

RESOLUTION 95-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF ST. LUCIE VILLAGE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO ENFORCE THE ST. LUCIE COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE AND/OR THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE ST. LUCIE VILLAGE NUISANCE ORDINANCE WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ST. LUCIE VILLAGE, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida, has previously adopted Ordinance 87-7, being the Village Nuisance Ordinance, which deals in part with animal nuisances; and

WHEREAS, St. Lucie County has adopted an Animal Control Ordinance which is applied in unincorporated portions of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida is desirous of providing for stricter enforcement of its restrictions on animal nuisances and the County's animal control regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Control Division, Department of Public Safety, St. Lucie County, Florida, has not previously been authorized to enforce such provisions within the Town of St. Lucie Village but the Board of Aldermen is currently willing to authorize the same; and,

WHEREAS, the public and the residents of Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida are taxed in relation to the provision of said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of St. Lucie Village, Florida:

1. The Animal Control Division, Department of Public Safety, St. Lucie County, Florida is authorized, concurrently with the Town of St. Lucie Village, to enforce the animal nuisance provisions of Ordinance 87-7 of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida.

2. The Animal Control Division, Department of Public Safety, St. Lucie County, Florida, is authorized to enforce the provisions of the St. Lucie County Animal Control Ordinance

within the municipal limits of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida, and specifically authorized to issue citations.

3. That, where the substantive provisions of the Animal Control Ordinance of St. Lucie County, Florida are specifically inconsistent with the provisions of the Animal Control provisions of the Nuisance Ordinance of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida, the provisions of the Nuisance Ordinance shall control; provided, however, that the Animal Control Division may issue verbal warnings in relation to any such violations.
