Proposed Ordinance 2020-1 is an Ordinance of the Town of St. Lucie Village, Florida, regulating the business hours of businesses which serve alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption to require such businesses to close at 11:00 p.m. in the evening and not to reopen for business until 7:00 a.m. in the morning or 1:00 p.m. on Sundays.
