

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS, PROPERTY OWNERS  
AND PUBLIC IN GENERAL OF ST. LUCIE VILLAGE, FLORIDA:**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Adjustment of St. Lucie Village, Florida will consider an application for variance at a meeting at the Village Hall on Tuesday, November 2, at 6:30 p.m.

The variance petition (or amendment) is submitted by Blaine and LaDonna Oney in relation to real property located in St. Lucie Village at 495 Peninsula Drive. The requested variance would grant relief from the setback requirements of the Zoning Ordinance, on all four sides of the property, so that improvements can be located as described and/or depicted in the variance application and accompanying paperwork.

The Board of Adjustment may grant or deny the petition, in whole or in part, or may continue the hearing from time to time as may be necessary. Any interested party may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed variance.
