Bill,

Rouse Road is scheduled for closing at the FEC crossing between 12/3/21 and 12/14/21 (12 days). Please take a look at the detour plan attached.

They are planning to route the detour along the east side of the tracks with two 10-foot lanes and a concrete jersey barrier between the temporary road and the track. The temporary road would extent about 0.5 mile north to the Michigan Street crossing.

Do you know of any reasons this may not work for the residents that live down Rouse Road? I'm not sure if we have the ability to request any changes at this point, but I wanted to get your feedback. We just recently received the details of this detour route or I would have ask sooner.
