AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF ST. LUCIE VILLAGE, FLORIDA, IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON ISSUANCE OF ANY NEW BUSINESS/OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE OTHER THAN FOR USES THAT ARE SPECIFICALLY LISTED IN ORDINANCE 87-5 OR THE ST. LUCIE VILLAGE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, AND ALSO EXCLUDING RENEWALS AND CERTAIN TRANSFERS OF EXISTING LICENSES FROM THE MORATORIUM, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A hearing on the ordinance will be held on February 20, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at the Village Hall, 2841 Old Dixie Highway, St. Lucie Village, Florida, for the first reading of the Ordinance.
