

UPDATED NOTICE – VILLAGE BOARD OF ALDERMEN

As of July 30, 2024, we now anticipate two vacancies on the Village Board of Aldermen, the governing body of the Town of St. Lucie Village.

Mayor Thiess, with the advice and consent of the remaining members of the Board of Aldermen may appoint a Village resident to complete the term of each resigning Board member. On these vacancies, one term will extend through the next election, the first Tuesday of May, 2025 and the other through the following election, the first Tuesday of May, 2026.

The Board of Aldermen will be asked for its advice and consent at its regular meeting on August 20th at 6:30 p.m., at the Village Hall, and it is expected that the Mayor will make a decision at that time. He may, however, defer a decision on one or both positions, to seek more applicants or otherwise.

The Board meets monthly on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. and has additional meetings, scheduled as needed. This is an unpaid position.

If we have multiple applicants for the positions the Mayor will likely ask the Board to rank those interested, compile the rankings and consider that in making a decision at this upcoming meeting.
