

NOTICE – VILLAGE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

There is an opening on the Village Board of Adjustment.

I will be asking the Board of Aldermen, at its regular meeting on November 19, 2024, at 6:30 p.m., to appoint an additional member to the Board of Adjustment to replace a retired member. The term, for which the appointment will be made, runs through April 30, 2027.

The Board of Adjustment has five members and determines whether to grant, and the extent of, variances (or relief) from the Village's Land Development Code.

Board members may be called on to attend monthly meetings, currently planned for the Wednesday each month following the regular Board of Aldermen meeting, starting at 6:30 p.m.

If we have multiple applicants for this position, I may ask the Board to rank those interested, compile the rankings and make a decision at the meeting.

The Board may choose to make a decision, or to defer a decision, to seek more applicants or otherwise at this meeting.
